RULES: Current USA Swimming (USA-S) and Iowa Swimming, Inc. (ISI) rules will govern this meet.

DATE: Sunday, January 14, 2007.

TIME: Warm-ups Noon - 12:50 p.m.
Competition 1:00 p.m.
Coaches Meeting 12:50 p.m.
Warm-ups will be split if needed and teams notified on Monday, January 8, 2007.

SITE: Loras College-San Jose Pool in the Graber Sports Center, on Cox St., between Loras Blvd. and Kirkwood. (See map).
Indoor, 6-lane 25 yd.
Water depth: 5 ½' - 6' at Starting Block end
4 ½' at shallow end
Colorado Timing System with button and watch back-up.

COACHES: Must possess and visibly wear a current USA Swimming Coaches Registration card. All coaches must sign-in when picking up their team's information packet or before actively taking part in coaching duties on the pool deck. Only USA Swimming registered coach members will be permitted on the deck in designated areas.

WARM-UPS: ISI Warm-up procedure will be followed. See ISI Code Book Section J. Swimmer(s) without a coach is to report to the Meet Referee prior to warm-up for lane assignments.

ENTRY

REQUIREMENTS:

- 1) All swimmers must be current USA Swimming registered athletes.
- 2) Contestants must enter the age bracket corresponding to their age the day of the meet, January 14, 2007.
- 3) A swimmer may enter the five individual events in their age group.
- 4) Seed times must be submitted for a 25 yd. course.
- 5) There will be a Clerk of Course, swimmers should report promptly when their event is called.
- 6) Phone entries will not be accepted.
- 7) Events will be pre-seeded.

ENTRY LIMIT: 100 Splashes / lane / session

- ENTRY FEES:
- 1) Individual events are \$2.00 per event.
 - 2) ISI Splash Fee is \$3.00 per swimmer.
 - 3) Make one check, payable to: DUBUQUE AREA SWIMMIN' HURRICANES.

- 4) Entry fees are not refundable. Splash fees will be refunded if the entire meet is cancelled.

Submitted entries on disk in Hy-Tek Commlink II format. When submitting disk entries, you must provide a printout of your entry for backup and the ISI Financial Sheet. Any team submitting entries on disk will receive the meet results on disk, at the end of the meet.

All hand entries in excess of 5 swimmers per team will be charged \$2 for each swimmer.

ENTRY

DEADLINE: Entries to be HAND-ENTERED must be received by 6:00 p.m., Thursday, January 4, 2007. UPS deliveries will be accepted all day. Incomplete entries will be returned and risk missing the meet. Emailed HyTek entries must be received by Noon, Monday, January 8, 2007, with hard copy and fees received by Wednesday, January 10, 2007. Express mailing entries should be sent "NO Signature Required".

SCORING: No points will be kept. See AWARDS for Pentathlon winner.

AWARDS: Individual Events: Ribbons 1 - 6 Place

The Overall Pentathlon Winner in each Age Group will receive a 1st place Medallion, the winner will be determined by total time of the swimmer competing in, and legally completing, all five events in their age group.

MEET OPERATION:

- 1) The meet host will attempt to allow adequate rest between events.
- 2) Swimmers must report promptly to the Clerk of Course.
- 3) Events may be combined and then separated for award purposes.

SCRATCHES: The ISI Scratch Rule is in effect. See ISI Code Book Section J.

MEET

COMMITTEE: A meet committee comprised of the Meet Referee, Meet Director, Coach Representative, Athlete Representative and one (1) Certified Official acting at large will be established to receive and act upon any administrative protest filed at the meet. The committee will not act upon judgment decisions as those are under the jurisdiction of the Meet Referee. This committee shall act as a review section in the need of an emergency meeting.

NO SMOKING: NO SMOKING in the swimming venue. Smoking is NOT allowed anywhere in the Graber Sports Center / San Jose Pool complex.
